Session One: Imagining the Possibilities

In this first session I am planning on focusing in on remembering our call, passion, God's power and the unlimited possibilities associated with God's generous love for us. As church leaders, we have been entrusted with the same extraordinary power to change the world. Our walk of faith begins when we remember that there's plenty we can do even when we feel like we don't have much to offer. Extravagant generosity or Christian leadership begins when we realize that we are called simply to do the same things that Jesus did first for us with joy and thanksgiving, namely we must get up, get out, get moving and give it all away. We are all called and commissioned to make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in His name so that we might transform the world...
